






#### LAND IN THE AREA OF KRAKOW (%)






#### LAND OWNERSHIP IN KRAKOW (%)


#### PURCHASE OF REAL PROPERTIES BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF KRAKOW




#### **BUDGET OF THE CITY OF KRAKOW IN 2018 (PLN)**
